Learning Update:

3 hour Speech and Language Preschool Class

- Color: Gray
- Shape: Diamond
- Letter: U, K, H, and Q
- Number: 8
- Theme: Weather, St. Patrick's Day, and Zoo

Visit the library and check out picture books without words. These books can allow your child to use his own language to tell the story. Children need to practice sequencing skills by retelling stories or stating how to complete an event like making a peanut butter & Jelly sandwich, or the steps involved with brushing teeth.

30 minute and 1 hour students

Children need to self monitor their own speech. Look for clues such as starting over and correcting his or her speech. Ask your child if he or she liked the way he or she said a particular word containing a specific speech sound. Reading a book that is saturated with your child's speech sounds is good for auditory bombardment
